ITEM 1 CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Hernandez called the meeting to order at 5:02 p.m. Roll Call established a quorum.

A) ROLL CALL AND POSSIBLE ACTION ON THE EXCUSING OF ANY ABSENT MEMBER OF THE GOVERNING BODY

Comm. Guajardo moved to excuse the absent member. Comm. Carrillo seconded the motion and when put to a vote, it carried unanimously.

B) PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE/INVOCATION

Juan G. Guerra, City Manager, led in the pledge of allegiance and David Garza said the invocation.

ITEM 2 PUBLIC COMMENTS/PUBLIC HEARINGS

A) PUBLIC COMMENTS

Juan G. Guerra, City Manager, introduced the item and called upon Pharr Community Theater. No one was present.

Kenneth C. Fletcher spoke about the home occupation by former City Attorney Miguel Angel Pruneda back in 2013 and voiced his concern with taxpayer monies being spend on his services. He also spoke about former PEDC individual's negotiations with Costco and stated activities were carried over to this date. Mr. Fletcher voiced his concern with public health issues stating individuals that obtain alcohol/health permits were not wearing their nametags. He stated they should comply with city ordinances.

Juan G. Guerra, City Manager, called upon Crisanto Garcia. Mr. Garcia was not present.

Frankie Herrera voiced his concern with no texting while driving and stated in June he was hit by a vehicle and the person was clearly not paying attention to the road. As a result, he was in ICU for five days with fractured bones and ribs. Mr. Herrera further mentioned he had been protesting at the intersection of Cage and Old Business 83 and in front of City Hall. He requested the Commission to pass an ordinance.

David Magallan extended an invitation to everyone to attend the No Puedo Callar Christian concert on May 5, 2017 at the Boggus Ford Events Center.

At this time, Mayor Hernandez informed the public that Ordinance No. O-2012-32 has been in place since August 21, 2012 in regards to no texting and driving. He stated public safety is the City's number one concern and fire and police need to make sure everything is followed accordingly.

B) PUBLIC HEARING ON DEVELOPMENT SERVICES CASES

Juan G. Guerra, City Manager, introduced the item. No one signed-up to speak therefore, the public hearing was closed.

ITEM 3 CITY MANAGER'S REPORTS

A) SUBMISSION OF MARCH 2017 TAX COLLECTION REPORT (FINANCE)

Juan G. Guerra, City Manager, introduced the tax collection report and stated both current and delinquent taxes were up. He further stated the city was doing fine.

B) SUBMISSION OF APRIL 2017 SALES TAX COLLECTION REPORT (FINANCE)

Juan G. Guerra, City Manager, introduced the sales tax collection report and stated the entire region was experiencing a negative sales tax collection rate for the month of April. He explained last year the city received a one-time payment but outside of that, sales tax were up by 1.55%.

C) CONSULTANTS QUARTERLY REPORT (ADMINISTRATION)

Juan G. Guerra, City Manager, introduced the consultants quarterly report and stated Hollis Rutledge and Ezequiel Ordonez were present for any questions. No questions were asked.

D) CITY EVENTS OF INTEREST (ADMINISTRATION)

Juan G. Guerra, City Manager introduced the City Events of Interest.

Mr. Guerra reported the South Texas Training Center would be holding their 20th Anniversary Ribbon Cutting on April 20, 2017 at 10:30 a.m. at 213 E. Ferguson, in Pharr. He stated this vocational school offers 1-2 year certifications in the medical field. He also announced PSJA PTI House Ribbon Cutting would be held on April 21, 2017 at 9:30 a.m. at 325 W. Jones, in Pharr and stated this home was purchased and remodeled by PSJA to assist special needs students in helping them adapt to a real life environment on their own. Mr. Guerra further reported a ribbon cutting for IDEA Pharr would take place on April 21, 2017 at 9:00 a.m. at 600 E. Las Milpas Road, in Pharr. He stated the event would consist of a city, Lionsville, within the school where kids mirror a real life city. Their city will include businesses such as Home Depot, and a police department. The children will participate as business owners or business managers and citizens.

Juan G. Guerra, City Manager, further reported a ribbon cutting for Ramirez Elementary would take place on April 27, 2017 at 10:00 a.m. at 1920 N. Hibiscus, in Pharr. He also reported a Get Financially Fit – SBA Financial Literacy Training would take place on April 27, 2017 at 10:00 a.m. at the Pharr Memorial Library. He stated this is an informational seminar for businesses to learn how to understand credit, improve their budget and reach financial goals. Mr. Guerra also reported Palm Valley Funeral Home would be holding a ribbon cutting on May 2, 2017 at 4:00 p.m. at 4607 N. Sugar Road, in Pharr.

Juan G. Guerra, City Manager, reminded everyone the National Day of Prayer would be on May 4, 2017 and invited the community to come together and pray as one for one hour. The event would begin at 12 noon at City Hall parking lot and the Walk of Faith would begin at 6:00 p.m. at Ashley Furniture in continuation with the celebration of National Day of Prayer.

Juan G. Guerra, City Manager, announced the Pharr Memorial Library would be hosting Dia de los Libros/Ninos on April 27, 2017 from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. and in celebration of Dia de los Ninos. Mr. Guerra also reported registrations for swimming lessons would begin on Saturday, April 22, 2017 and at the Parks and Recreation website and at their offices located at 413 E. Clark.

Juan G. Guerra, City Manager, invited the community to attend the ARISE Youth Group Earth Day celebration on Saturday, April 22, 2017 from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. at the Universal Estates Park located at 300 E. Comet Drive. Mr. Guerra reported the Bridge Department would be hosting a BridgeConnect Trade Session on April 26 and 27, 2017 from 9:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. at Tierra Del Sol Golf Course. He stated this seminar is an ACE Outreach Seminar with topics such as the latest on ACE filing and tips from experience.

Juan G. Guerra, City Manager, invited everyone to attend the Community Development Block Grant Day on Wednesday, April 19, 2017 from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. at City Hall lobby area. Mr. Guerra further reported on upcoming events at the Boggus Ford Events Center.

At this time, Juan G. Guerra, City Manager, recognized firefighter Jose Perez as this year's Firefighter of the Year. He stated the Rio Grande Valley Firefighters and Fire Marshal's Association consisting of 37 fire departments from Zapata to Cameron Counties recognized Mr. Perez as Firefighter of the Year at their Quarterly Meeting on April 9, 2017. He stated the criteria considered for the award was attitude, work knowledge, creativity, ability and innovation, department involvement, community involvement, and heroism/bravery. He stated Firefighter Perez has been involved in our department for eight years and has demonstrated a complete knowledge of his

job duties and a great team member on his crews while responding to calls. He has made our physical fitness training fun by implementing boxing exercises into our program which the firefighters have enjoyed and has volunteered his time with the Pharr Police Athletic League as a boxing coach for the youth of Pharr. Mr. Perez has helped a fire victim bring their home into compliance after a major fire damaged their electrical wiring at no cost to the family. Firefighter Perez thanked the Commission and staff for the recognition and stated he was very proud of working for our city.

At this time, Comm. Elizondo recognized David Garza, Public Utilities Director, for his years of service and wished him good luck in his future endeavors.

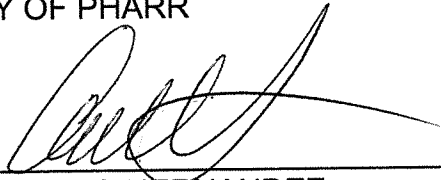
Juan G. Guerra, City Manager, introduced the item and recommended approval as discussed in closed session.

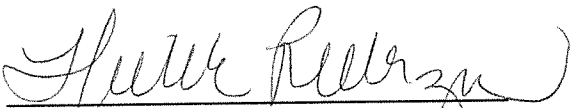
