ITEM 7 ADMINISTRATIVE REPORTS

Police Chief Villescas introduced Promoted Officer Michael Rodriguez to the Commission, he is a former Marine and is honored to serve the City of Pharr. Chief Villescas also invited the members to the scheduled promotional ceremony. He also reported that Fitness Assessments were scheduled for existing officers for the week of May 30. He also mentioned that all uniformed officers are carrying body cameras and that soon enough thru a grant, all Investigating personnel will too have body cams. The current eligibility list for PD has been exhausted; however (3) vacancies remain due to resignations. The process will begin using the same list, however now considering Non-certified candidates from the list who will be eligible to attend the Police Academy. Currently 4 cadets attending the Police Academy at STC will be graduating on June 22, 2017.

Fire Chief Perez reported that 18 personnel from Fire department completed an EMT Course and are now eligible to take the national registry test which will allow these individuals to provide more medical attention to the civilians of Pharr. The Fire department has received new SCBA's (self-contained breathing apparatus) as well as individual masks for all firefighters, reducing cross contamination and the spreading of illnesses.

Director Alanis reported the launching of the City of Pharr's employee of the month program and recognized Firefighter Jose Perez as the first employee selected to receive the award. Mrs. Alanis also reported that the fire department lost 2 Fire Inspectors a few months ago and that the current Collective Bargaining Agreement states that as those positions become available, they must be replaced with Civil Service Personnel. 2 promotional exams have been scheduled to fill these vacancies and Fire personnel did not pass either exam. Vacancies will be filled with assigned civil service personnel as stated in CBA.
