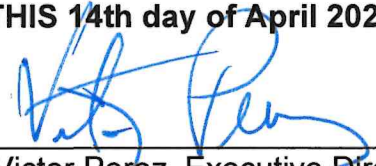

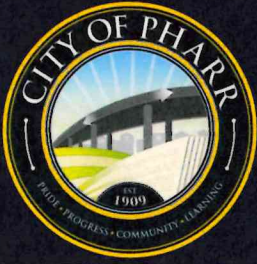

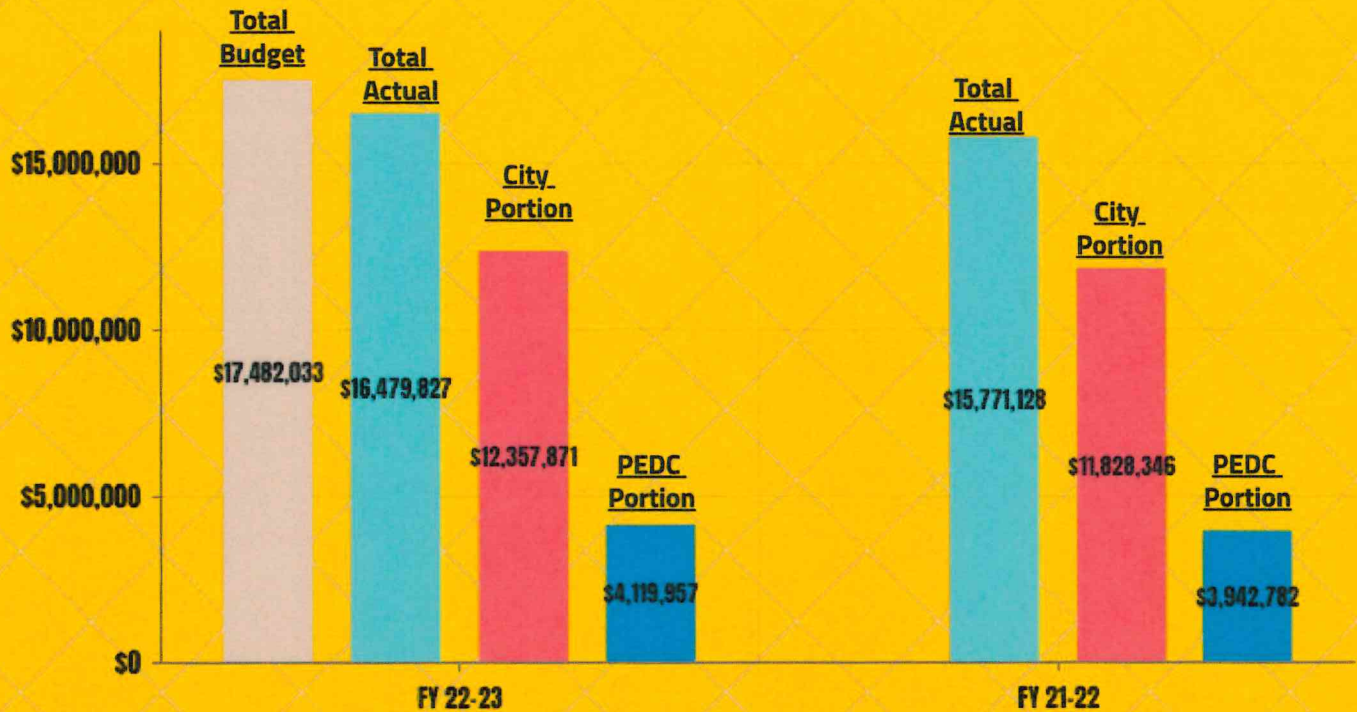

She stated the Pharr EDC would be hosting C & J Logistical Services Groundbreaking February 24, 2023, at 11:00 a.m. for the expansion of local business, she stated C & J was established as an international logistics company, providing services necessary for the movement of goods across international borders and have been in operation in the City of Pharr for over twenty years.

Karina Lopez, Economic Development Manager, extended an invitation to the community and the Board to South Texas Health Systems Groundbreaking Thursday March 9, 2023 at 10:00 a. m. West Ridge Rd. and Cage Blvd. She stated it would be a Freestanding Emergency Department with the capacity of treating general emergency cases on an outpatient basis, she further stated the facility is set to provide over 25 healthcare related employment opportunities.

B) PEDC II BUSINESS GRANT PROGRAM.

Karina Lopez, Economic Development Manager informed the Board about the PEDC Business Grant Program. She stated that while we currently provide incentive support for the development of some small and mid to large businesses within our community, now the Pharr EDC would be launching additional support specifically for our small businesses. Small businesses continue to be an integral part of our local economy by spurring employment, providing access to local products and services, and fueling our economy by keeping disposable income and tax money within our communities. The programs are set to launch mid to late March of 2023. She further stated that we encourage the community to stay tuned to our website at pharredc.com and our social media platforms @pharredc for the official launch and program guidelines.
